Air Quality Operating Permit to Construct #AP4953-2525 (FIN: A0991) – New**

Dear Mr. Sangiacomo:

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection - Bureau of Air Pollution Control (NDEP-BAPC) received an application prepared by Stantec Consulting, Inc. from Jungo Land and Investments, Inc. for the Jungo Disposal Site in Humboldt County on January 8, 2009 for the above referenced permit. The application is complete by default on February 25, 2009 per NAC 445B.3395.1. After preliminary review of the submitted materials, the NDEP-BAPC has determined that the following information is needed in order to continue processing the application:

- Appendix I (Industrial Process Application Form for the Municipal Solid Waste Landfill)
 - Section 2.f. – Once approved by the Waste Management Division, the description should read, “Waste accepted is per approved Solid Waste Disposal Permit #SW495REV0”.
 - Section 7 – Include the PTE for HAPs in tons/year and also note that LANDGem model results are contained in Appendix 5 and not Appendix 4.

The NDEP-BAPC will continue with the technical review of your application for renewal. However, in accordance with NAC 445B.3395.3, if after the official date of submittal the NDEP-BAPC discovers that additional information is required to act on the application, the NDEP-BAPC may request additional information. The NDEP-BAPC must receive a copy of the items above no later than April 1, 2009. Any delay in providing the requested information will result in a corresponding delay in the action of the NDEP-BAPC on your application for renewal pursuant to NAC 445B.3395.3.
